**DUTIES:**

The Poughkeepsie City School District (PCSD) is committed to providing students and parents with pathways to opportunity that will lead to achievement and success. Through student-centered effective and transformational leadership, school and community engagement, and an unrelenting pursuit to achieve greater school outcomes for children, the Poughkeepsie City Schools is focused on developing and growing greater access, equity, opportunity, and quality across PCSD.

The PCSD High School Summer Program will provide targeted academic support for students who are “at risk, require credit recovery, or additional regents. Teachers will provide both enrichment and academic interventions in core academic courses to achieve their credits/regents and to reduce learning loss over the summer months and to support skills development in areas of struggle in preparation for the next grade level. Summer program classes are contingent upon student enrollment at a teacher-student ratio of 1:25.

Responsibilities include:

- Designing lessons and providing core academic instruction utilizing various instructional delivery methods and strategies such as technology assisted instruction, individualized and small group activities;
- Engaging students in rigorous, targeted instruction in core academic classes to build skill and

- confidence, preparing the students for the following grade level;
- Utilizing grade level appropriate, research-based curriculum techniques to ensure student progress.
- Maintain accurate data to monitor student progress and attendance records;
- Establish a well-organized, attractive and relaxed classroom atmosphere in a print rich environment;
- Prepare for regents exams in August
- Proctor Regents Exams, score, monitor
- Communicate with parents/guardians regarding student academic and behavioral progress.
- Any additional duties requested by the summer school administrator
- Global Teacher may include Econ/Part in Gov.
