DUTIES:

The Poughkeepsie City School District (PCSD) is committed to providing students and parents with pathways to opportunity that will lead to achievement and success. Through student-centered effective and transformational leadership, school and community engagement, and an unrelenting pursuit to achieve greater school outcomes for children, the Poughkeepsie City Schools is focused on developing and growing greater access, equity, opportunity, and quality across PCSD.

As reflected in the approved curriculum writing proposal, curriculum writers will align the Financial Algebra course to the Next Generation math standards:

- Day 1-2 Curriculum writers will create a new and complete content curriculum map aligned to the Next Generation Mathematics Learning Standards. Curriculum writers will align standards (w/Algebra I), create essential questions, add student learning objectives and list Tier III vocabulary terms within each unit of study.
- Day 3 (include Special Education teacher) Writers will also highlight interdisciplinary connections, as appropriate. They will share resources, strategies for instruction and differentiation and IEP and ENL considerations.
- Day 4-5 (include Special Education teacher) Curriculum writers will create assessments.
 Assessments may be both formative and summative. Summative assessments and projects will be provided for each unit. A final exam will be created.

Curriculum writers will submit their work half way through the process (after 2 days of work) for feedback and written approval prior to completing the project.

APPOINTMENT:

Appointment will be made by the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the Superintendent following assessment of training, experience, certifications, credentials and evaluation of service. Personal interviews shall be conducted where appropriate.

EFFECTIVE DATE: All curriculum writers are expected to submit their curricula for feedback and approval no later than Aug 1, 2022 and all work to be completed no later than Sep 1, 2022.

SALARY: As per PPSTA contract

- 1 mathematics teacher not to exceed 30 hours or \$2,100
- 1 special education teacher not to exceed 18 hours or \$1,260
