- Inspects pool facilities, equipment, and water to ensure that they are safe and usable.
- Assists in cleaning the pool and related facilities and equipment assist with chlorine residual water tests and with records and charts of water tests and records of accidents.
- Instructs or assists classes in fundamentals of swimming as needed.
- Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations.
- Skill in the application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques.

- Ability to pass a pre-employment physical skills evaluation as stipulated by the department.
- Ability to prepare routine administrative paperwork.
- Knowledge of CPR and emergency medical procedures.
- Ability to follow routine verbal and written instructions.
- Knowledge of customer service standards and procedures.
