NYSED will not approve any SCEP from a school identified as Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) until the plan demonstrates evidence that stakeholders have meaningfully participated in the development of the SCEP."

**DUTIES:**

The Poughkeepsie City School District (PCSD) is committed to providing students and parents with pathways to opportunity that will lead to achievement and success. Through student-centered effective and transformational leadership, school and community engagement, and an unrelenting pursuit to achieve greater school outcomes for children, the Poughkeepsie City Schools is focused on developing and growing greater access, equity, opportunity, and quality across PCSD.

The SCEP oversight team will work in collaboration with school partners and stakeholders to develop recommendations for improvement of the school and to solicit input regarding their recommendations through public engagement. The SCEP Oversight Team will review the School Comprehensive Education Plan (SCEP) and/or School Continuation Plan (SCP) to determine if revisions are necessary.

The duties of the SCEP Oversight Team include, but are not exclusively limited to the following responsibilities:

- Assess the degree to which the 2022-2023 School Comprehensive Education Plan (SCEP)/School Continuation Plan is successfully being implemented
- Collect, analyze, and report on school-based data related to 2022-2023 SCEP goals and targets (such as i-Ready, attendance, behavior, DTSDE survey results, state testing, FILWs etc.)
- Support the school leadership in completing quarterly reports on progress made towards 2022-2023 SCEP goals, as needed

- Complete a needs assessment, specifically including input from staff, students, and parents via survey and/or interviews, to determine how the school is currently positioned to support student success prior to writing their annual improvement plan.
- Collaborate with school stakeholders (staff, students, parents) to write the 2023-2024 SCEP
- Complete and submit a draft 2023-2024 SCEP to the Director of Elementary Education by end of day June 9, 2023.
- Create a presentation of the 2023-2024 SCEP for school leadership to present to the Board of Education for approval at a date to be determined

**APPOINTMENT:**

Appointment will be made by the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the Superintendent following assessment of training, experience, certifications, credentials and evaluation of service. Personal interviews shall be conducted where appropriate.
