The Poughkeepsie City School District (PCSD) is committed to providing students and parents with pathways to opportunity that will lead to achievement and success. The PCSD High School Summer Program will provide targeted academic support for students who are "at risk, require credit recovery, or additional regents. Teachers will provide both enrichment and academic interventions in core academic courses to achieve their credits/regents and to reduce learning loss over the summer months and to support skills development in areas of struggle in preparation for the next grade level. Summer program classes are contingent upon student enrollment at a teacher-student ratio of 1:25.

Responsibilities include:

- The counselor will conduct parent and student outreach to ensure the student attends credit recovery
- The counselors will check with credit recovery teachers to gather attendance reports.
- The counselor will maintain all records of attendance and outreach
- The counselor will provide weekly reports and updates to the principal/counselors
- The counselor will monitor students' progress and provide guidance, counseling, support, and Outreach to support student success.
- The counselor will work cooperatively with teachers, administrators, and colleagues.
- Effectively use the computer and technology to support effective instructions and student learning.
