#### Scope of work

- Emergency lockdown buttons in the main offices
- 360 new video surveillance cameras & network video recording servers
- Card access control on exterior doors
- Door contacts on exterior doors (confirmation doors are not left open)

#### Emergency Lockdown Buttons

- Automatically lockdown a school from the press of a button.
- Located in offices and administrative areas.
- Automatically lock perimeter doors and stop card access entry for traditional staff.
- Automated call to 911



#### Video surveillance

- High resolution video
- Clear images
- Ability to zoom into areas of interest
- Rapid video searching through object classification (person or vehicle)
- No facial recognition features



# Card access control on exterior doors

- Manage when and where people enter the buildings
- Easily activate and deactivate a person's card



#### Door contacts on exterior doors

Alerts when a door is left open



#### Scope of work

- Middle School & High School digital notification signage
- Exterior blue light strobes (activated during lockdown events)
- Emergency audio messaging through the existing PA announcement system
- Weapons detection walk-through screening systems (High School and Middle School)

#### Digital notification signage (HS & MS)

- Automatically deliver visual and audio messaging during lockdown events.
- Displays the current time (synchronized to internet time servers)
- Devices located in:
  - Classrooms
  - Hallways
  - Gyms
  - Offices








#### Exterior blue lights

- Alert people on the exterior of the building that a lockdown event is currently active.
- Notify visitors not to approach the building.



#### PA system announcements

 Automatically play lockdown emergency messaging over the existing PA system.



#### Weapons Detection System

- Scans and locates firearms (not a metal detector)
- Preserves student dignity
  - Walk through at a normal pace
  - No need to empty pockets or bags
- Help students spend more time in class
  - The system can scan 1 person per second
  - People can walk through in groups





## Funding Discussion

- 1. Phase I Student and Staff Safety \$2,190,000
- 2. Phase II Emergency Notification and Weapon Detection \$906,800
- 3. Both Phase I and II will be funded through the district's Smart Schools Bond fund allocation.

#### Smart Schools Bonds - Budget Amendment Necessary
