Dutchess County now has three vaccines — Pfizer and Moderna, which each require two doses spread out over weeks — and Johnson & Johnson, which requires one dose.



The vaccines have been:

- Authorized by the FDA
- Tested through large clinical studies
- Reviewed by independent organizations
- Shown to be highly effective at preventing COVID-19
- Will not give you COVID-19
